This is an example of a mounted, square print.

Packaging – there are 2 options

- 1) With a white mount – posted flat between board.
- 2) Without a mount, posted rolled up in a tube (this option is less expensive to buy and post). I recommend overseas customers use the second option as postal rates are so high right now.

To process your order I need the following information:

- 1) The name and number of the picture
- 2) How you'd like to pay
- 3) Your postal address – even if you've ordered before, this really helps.

If you don't hear from me within 24 hours, please check your junk/spam folder.

1 Print sizes:

- Square prints are 19cm by 19cm. Mounts are 30cm by 30cm (12" by 12").
- Rectangular prints have a long edge of 30.5cm (widths vary). Mounts are 30cm by 45cm (12" by 18").

Some prints come without mounts as they are too big or too long.

Print prices are inclusive of 20% VAT.
