

Larger Limited Edition Giclée Prints : how to order

Print sizes:

Square prints are 30cm by 30cm.

Rectangular prints are 42cm along their long edge (short edge varies).

Prints are posted without mounts (rolled up in a tube) and I do not offer a framing service for prints this size.

Cost:

A single prints cost **£40 plus £5.39 UK postage**.

DISCOUNTS for multiple purchases:

Two prints cost £70 plus £5.39 UK postage (that's £35 each).

Three prints cost £90 plus £5.39 UK postage (that's £30 each).

Prints are posted 1st Class and always require a signature.

Payment Options (bank transfer is by far the most helpful as it saves the big fees paypal and card companies charge me).

- 1) Bank transfer – I will email you the details.
- 2) Credit/Debit card – I will email you an invoice so you can pay securely online.
- 3) Paypal – I will email you an invoice so you can pay securely online.

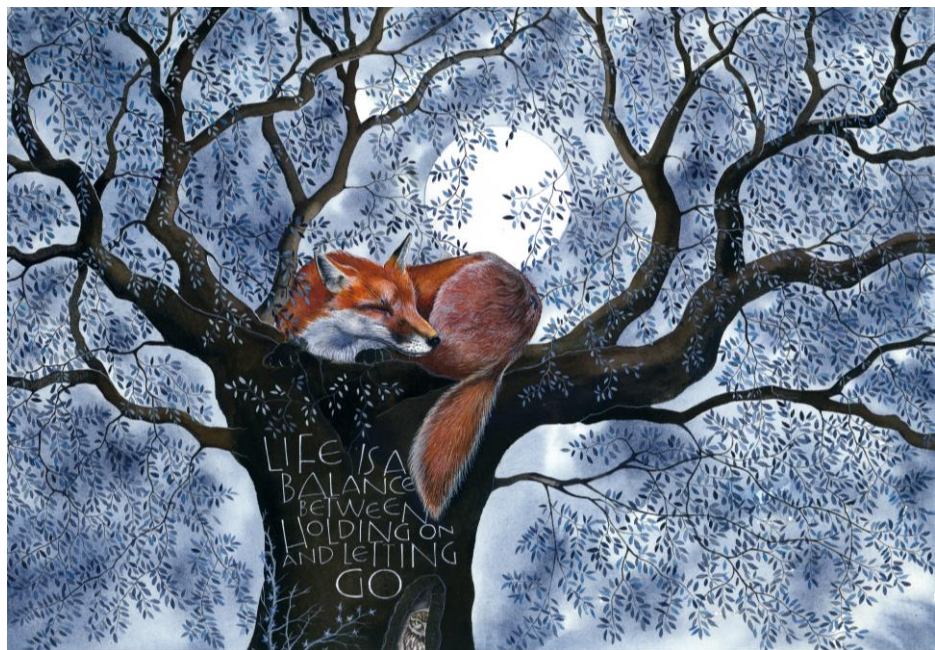

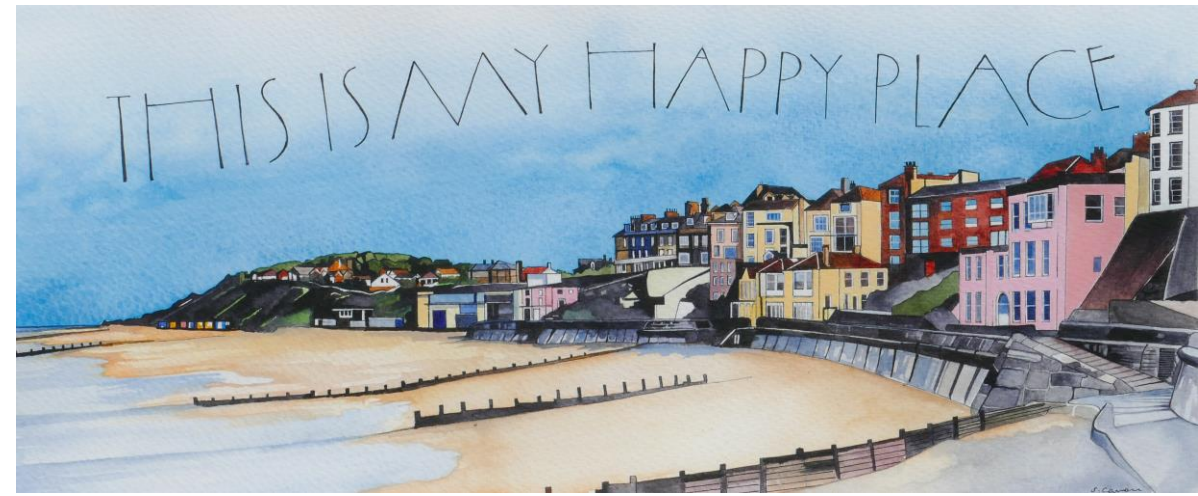

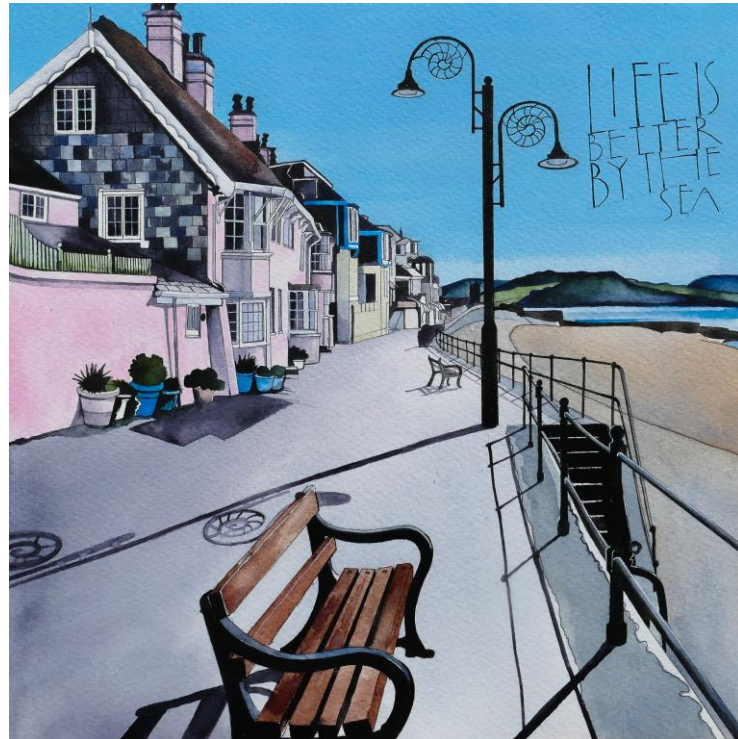

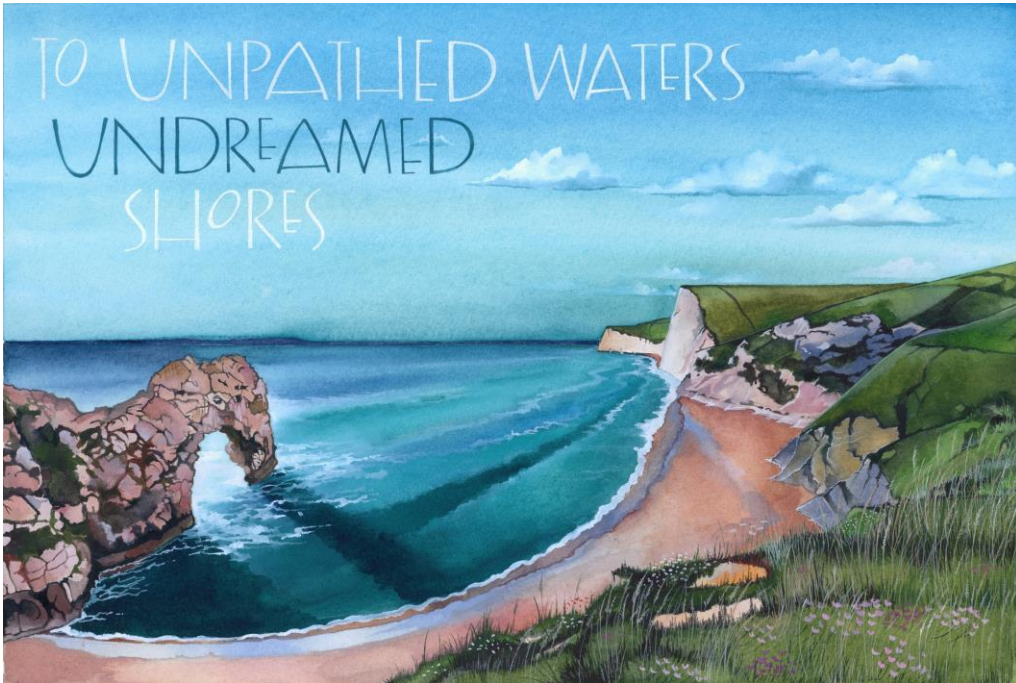
